Peg Monster Magnets

Audience: Children and their families

You will need the following:

- Wooden pegs
- Wool—preferably different colours and textures
- Pipe cleaners
- Googly eyes
- Beads
- Sharpies
- Craft glue
- Magnet strip
- Paint if you want to paint them first. The pegs for the holiday sessions will come pre-stained with food colouring



1/2 - 1 hour - depends how many each child makes.

Preparation:

Have a go yourself and make some samples.
















Choose your peg colour. Wrap some wool around 3 or 4 fingers. You could use one colour or 2 or 3 to create a multi-coloured effect.



Once you have enough slide it off your fingers and tie another piece of wool around the middle with a double knot.




Cut the looped ends of your wool bundle creating a thin pom pom.




Add glue to the inside top of your peg and push in the pom pom to create hair.





Use a short pipe cleaner (or cut a longer one in half) and push it through the spring in the middle of the peg.



String a bead on to each end of the pipe cleaner and twist back on itself to make hands. Bend the pipe cleaners to look more like arms.



Glue on your googly eyes (if using) or draw on eyes with sharpies. Draw on a mouth with a sharpie - you could add tiny paper teeth if you felt like it!



Glue the magnet strip to the back of the peg (plain magnet side out). Leave to dry - the googly eyes, hair and magnet will need time to dry. Once, dry attach your picture or notice to your fridge with your personalised peg!
