

Paper Flower Bouquet

Audience:

All age groups. If you have younger children, parental help may be Required.

You will need the following:

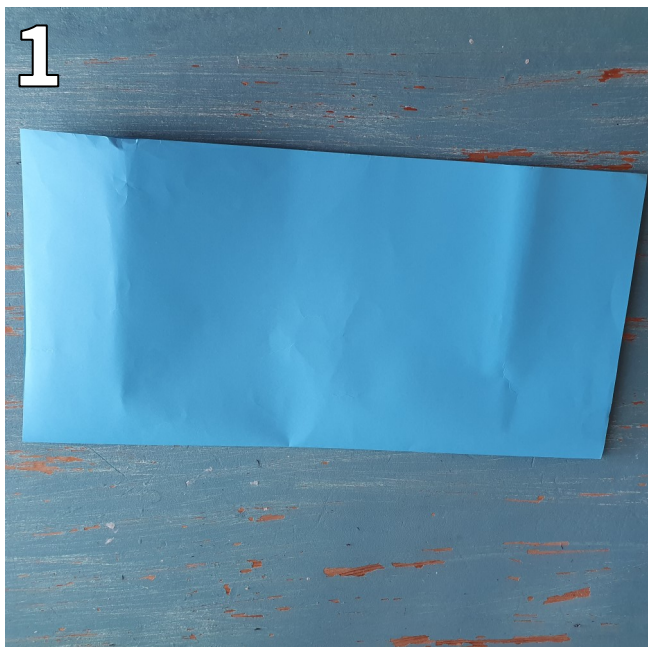
- Coloured Paper
- Glue stick / double sided tape
- Scissors
- Pen/pencil

Session length:

About 30 minutes. Longer if the children get involved with complex decoration.

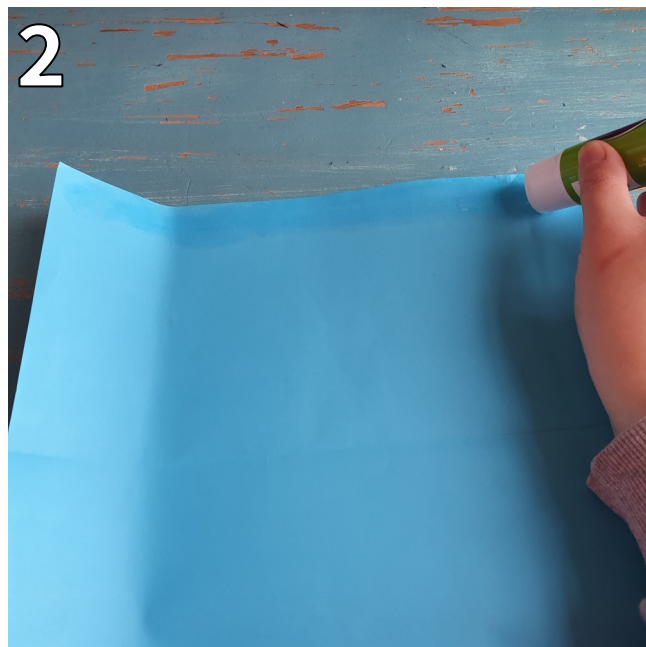


1



Take one piece of paper and fold it in half long ways, or horizontally.

Apply some glue to one of the edges of the paper.

3



Fold the edge of the paper.

4



Use the scissors to make cuts (the flower stems) From the bottom of the paper to the folded line.

Apply some glue to one of the edges of the paper.

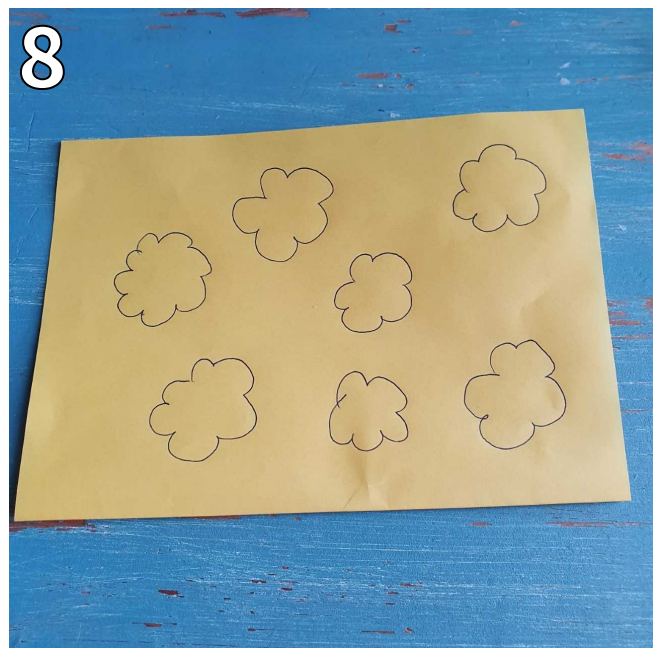
Roll and wrap the stems to make into a tube.

It is your stem part!

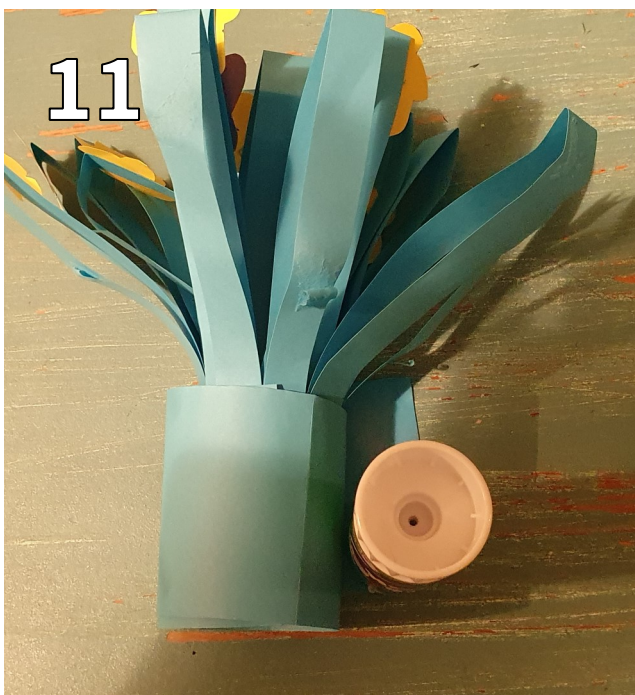
Use a pen or pencil to draw as many flowers as you need.



Decorate your flowers.



Attach your flowers to the stem.



Grab another piece of paper and roll and wrap the paper to make into a bouquet holder. Apply some glue to one of the edges of the paper.



Spread your stems out. Now you're done!
