

Spring Tree

Audience: All age groups. If you have younger children, parental help may be required.

You will need the following:

- Coloured Paper– brown/green/pink or other bright coloured paper
- Glue stick / double sided tape
- Scissors
- Pen/pencil

Session length:

About 30 minutes. Longer if the children get involved with complex decoration.

Take one piece of brown paper and fold it in half.

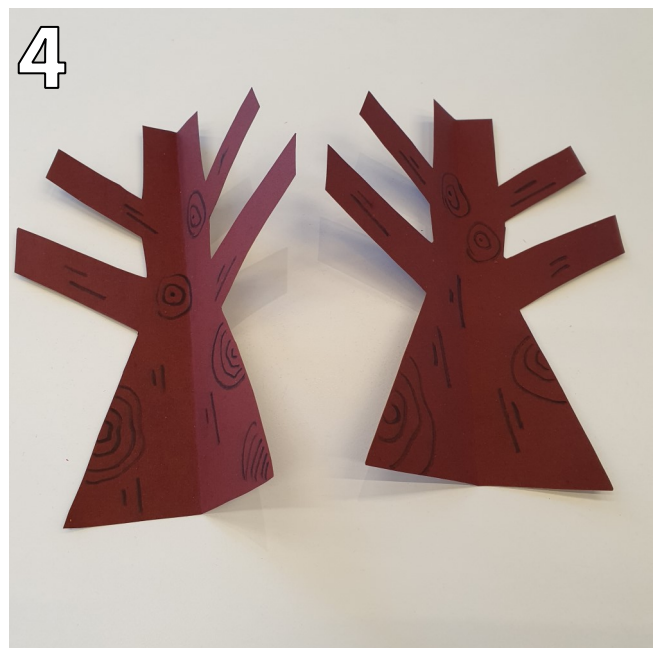
Use a pen to draw your tree and cut it out.

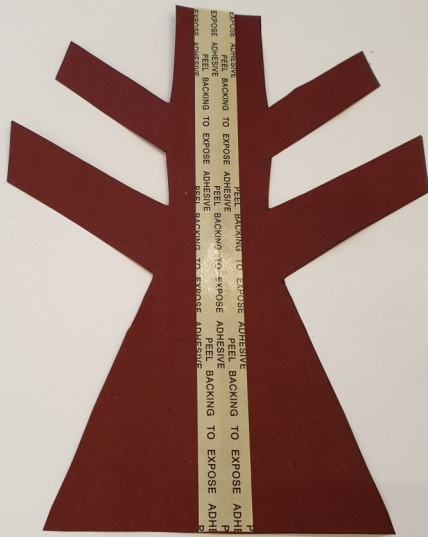
Draw tree growth rings.

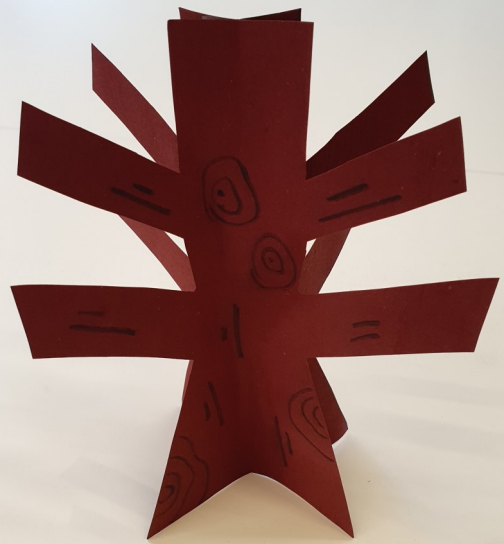
Make two trees.

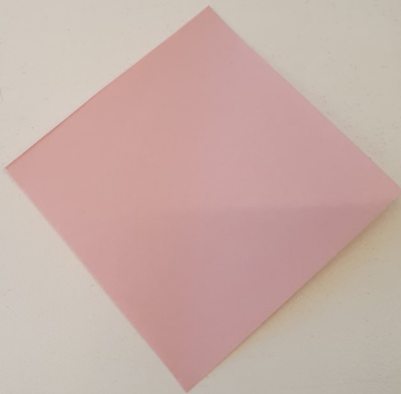
Apply double-sided tape to the middle of the tree.

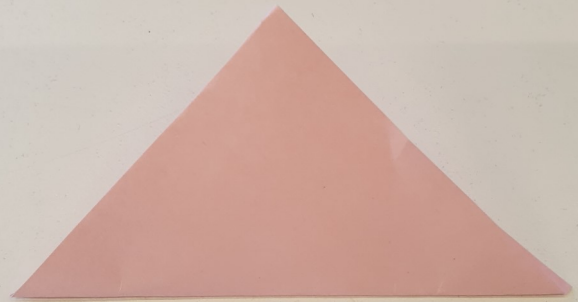
Attach the two trees together.

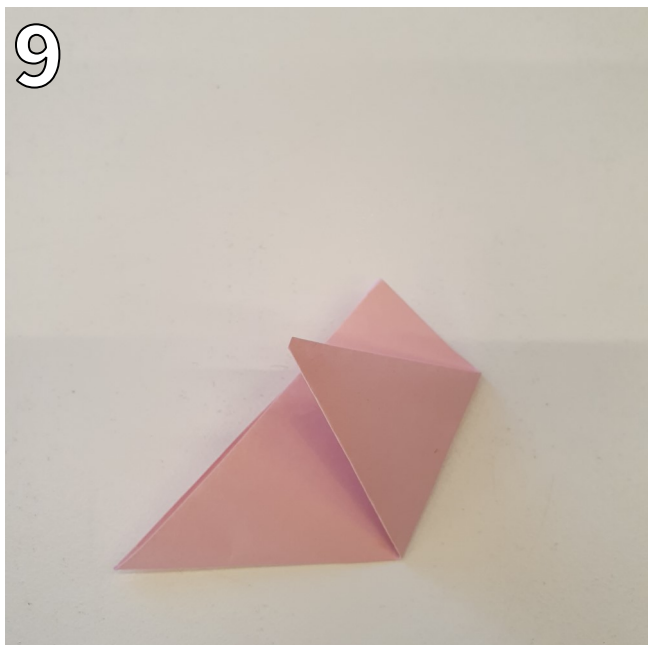
Take one square piece of paper.

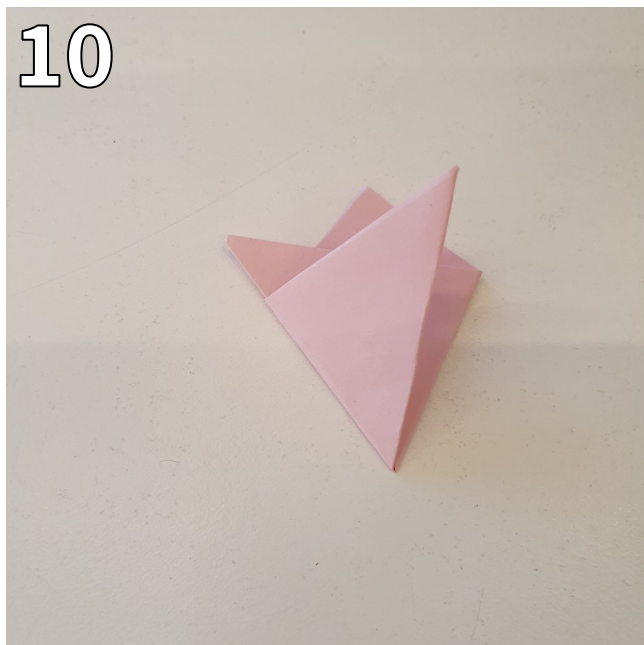
Fold the bottom corner to the top corner (make it a triangle).

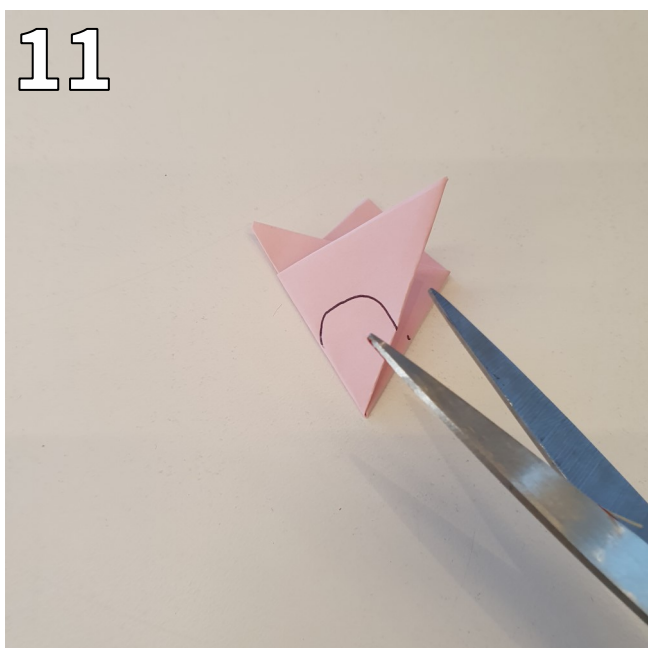
Fold the right side to the left,
like so.

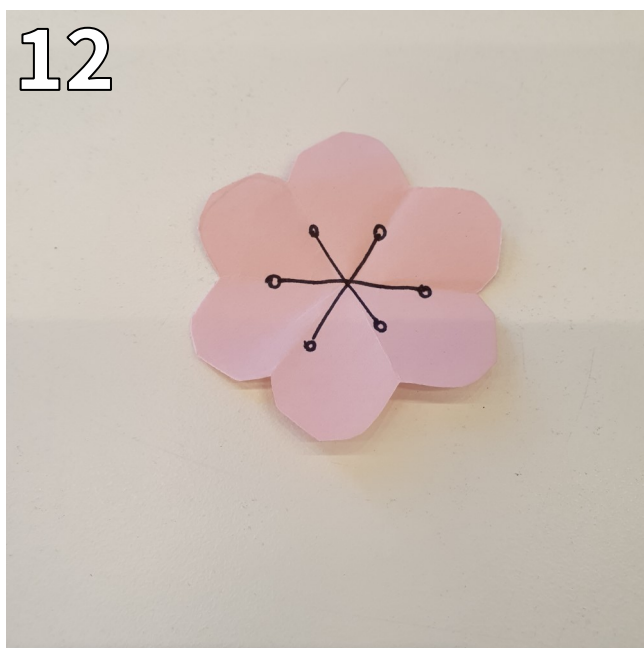
Fold the left side to the right,
like so.

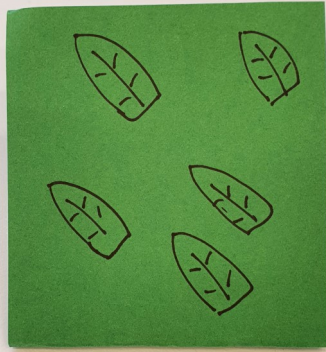
Draw a half circle in the bottom
corner and cut it out.

Unfold the flower and decorate it.
Make as many flowers as you want.

13



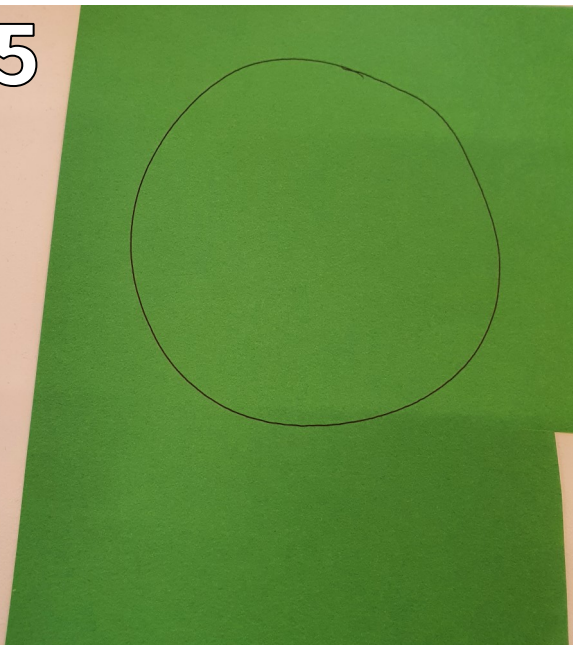
Draw leaves and cut them out.

Use a glue stick to attach flowers and leaves on the tree.

Take a piece of paper. Draw a circle and cut it out.

Use a glue stick or double-sided tape and attach the tree to the circle on the bottom. Now you're done!
