Spring Tree

Audience: All age groups. If you have younger children, parental help may be required.

You will need the following:

- Coloured Paper brown/green/pink or other bright coloured paper
- Glue stick / double sided tape
- Scissors
- Pen/pencil

Session length:

About 30 minutes. Longer if the children get involved with complex decoration.







Take one piece of brown paper and fold it in half.



Use a pen to draw your tree and cut it out.



Draw tree growth rings.




Make two trees.






Apply double-sided tape to the middle of the tree.



Attach the two trees together.




Take one square piece of paper.




Fold the bottom corner to the top corner (make it a triangle).






Fold the right side to the left, like so.



Fold the left side to the right, like so.



Draw a half circle in the bottom corner and cut it out.



Unfold the flower and decorate it. Make as many flowers as you want.






Draw leaves and cut them out.



Use a glue stick to attach flowers and leaves on the tree.



Take a piece of paper. Draw a circle and cut it out.



Use a glue stick or double-sided tape and attach the tree to the circle on the bottom. Now you're done!
