Christchurch City Libraries provides quality resources and services to connect people, inspire discovery, and enrich communities. The Content Development Policy documents the principles and strategies for developing and managing the collections held by the Library, and the criteria used to determine what is added to, and removed from the collection. This criteria applies to both purchased and donated resources.

The Library is pleased to receive donations for its collections. Donations are an important part of the development of the library collections, particularly for building the archives and permanent collections. If a zine donation is accepted for the general collection, it will be processed and located at one of the Library's network locations, and managed accordingly. It will be withdrawn from the collection when it is no longer suitable for library use.

In addition to the criteria outlined in the Content Development Policy, Zine donations must

- Be in excellent physical condition
- Have relevance to the residents of the city
- Be in an existing format used by Library customers


## Terms of donation

The donor understands and accepts the terms of donation as specified in this policy:

- The criteria under which donations are accepted
- Donations are assessed by collection experts for their suitability to be added to the collection
- Any donations considered unacceptable will be sent to the Library's Booksale, or disposed of
- In most instances, donations become the property of the Library.
