



Matariki Shadow Picture Make Sheet

Ngā Tohutohu | Instructions

You will need:

- Three templates
- A blank A4 piece of paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Stuff to colour in with



First, prepare your 3 templates

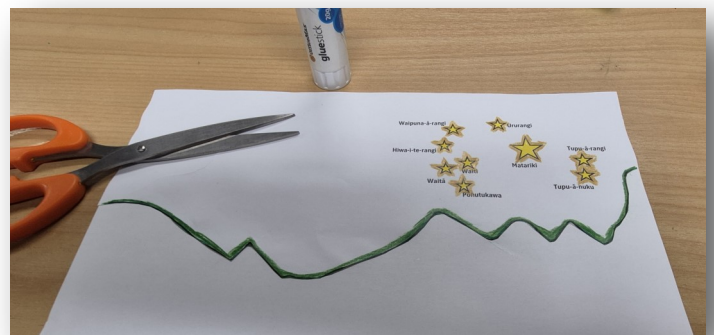
Colour along the lines of all the templates. This will make it easier to see them in the finished product.

You can use any colour/s—don't forget to colour in the stars.

You can even add trees & grass to the middle template (like in the picture).

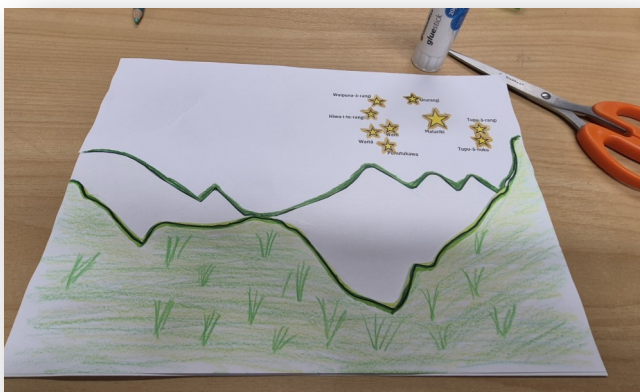
Next, cut out the back template by cutting **under the line**. This will help make your line look thicker

And then stick the cutout to the top of the blank A4 piece of paper (*like in the picture*)

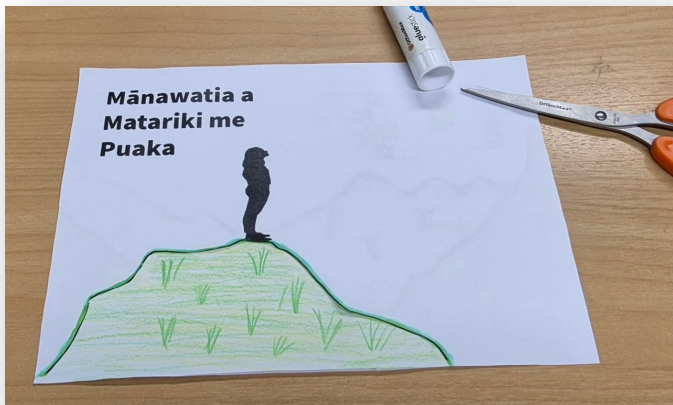
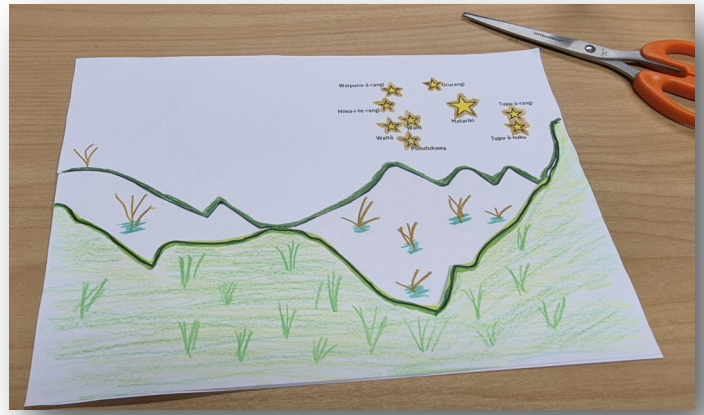


Now, cut out the middle template by cutting on **top of the line**. Again this will help make your line look thicker.

& stick it to the bottom of the blank A4 (*like in the picture*)



Next, you can draw some grasses or trees in the space between the top & bottom template OR you can leave it blank—the choice is yours



Then, cut out the top template by cutting on **under the line**. Again this will help make your line look thicker.

Now, stick it on top of your other templates on the blank A4 paper. (*like in the picture*) ensure the corners all meet and that there is glue on the stars to help them shine through.

You can always trim off any bits that might stick out. You can also decorate your picture however you like.

Next, find window or something that can shine light through your work and enjoy!
